## Capital Donations...Did You Know?

<u>Did you know that Capital Donations are one of our top 4</u> <u>fundraisers, along with GoPlaySave book sales, Book Fair,</u> and Rocket Raffle?



At a recent PTA meeting we became aware that many families, especially those newer to PSE, did not know we rely heavily on Capital Donations. We do this because parents have told us they would rather make a straight donation than be asked to participate in "sales-type" fundraisers. GoPlaySave is the only selling-type fundraiser we use, and that is because it has such a high profit margin (\$15 per book sold), and it can pay for itself by using the coupons.

In addition, we learned that parents sometimes did not know the kinds of things PTA money is spent on. *The PTA pays for things that our school relies on every day.* For example, so far this year we have paid for printer ink, costs associated with moving the computer lab (to make room for needed Kindergarten classrooms), teacher training and professional development, carpets for the new cottage classrooms, and the use of the Accelerated Reader (AR) program. Furthermore, costs for things like printer ink, teacher professional development, and outdoor maintenance are expenditures we continue to incur throughout the year.
