1. Go to join.myschoolanywhere.com
2. Enter our code: psepta
3. Follow the screen prompts to securely enter your family's information

We will be notified of your entry. Once we confirm that you're a PSE family, we'll accept your info into the directory and email instructions for creating your password-protected account(s). You do not have to purchase access in order to be included, but you won't be able to view the full directory unless you've purchased access.

## STEP 2 - Purchase Access (optional, but recommended!)

1. Purchase the Directory item on Pay4SchoolStuff.com (under Back to School Forms, Fees \& Purchases). Remember:
Just \$2 for the whole family (includes up to 4 individual accounts)

2. Within 48 hours of receiving your order, we'll activate your access so you can view the entire directory

## Important Parking Information

Our wonderful community partner, Providence Presbyterian Church, allows us the use of their parking lot during school events when the PSE lot and the CATS lot on Alexa Rd. become full. Do not block other cars in or park in the fire lane at PSE or at the church.

## Please fill the CATS lot first before using the church lot.

Please use the first two rows of available parking nearest the street in the church lot. Be sure not to block entrances or driveways in and out of the church.Be sure to leave time to walk down to the school.

The small lot to the right of the church is never available for PSE event parking neither is the area in front of the cemetery.

All cars parked in our driveway or around the median in our parking lot must be moved from those areas by $2: 40 \mathrm{pm}$ due to our buses arriving and the carpool line.

## School Attendance Facts

1. If your child will not be attending school, please send an email to pseabsent@cms.k12.nc.us with the reason for the absence.
2. If your child has an unexcused absence or tardy, an automated phone call will be generated from the district to the home phone number listed in powerschool. If you have already notified us as to the reason for your child's absence there is nothing else you need to do. The phone calls are generated each day and unfortunately we cannot turn them off.
3. A complete explanation of excused (lawful) and unexcused (unlawful) reasons for missing school can be found in the parent handbook located on the PSE website under forms and information. The state requires the school to send home letters when a student accrues unexcused absences even when we are informed as to the reason for these absences.
4. A student must be in school for 210 minutes in order for the day to count. For example, your student arrives at school on time (8:00 am) and gets picked up at 11:15. The time would not add up to enough minutes and therefore the student would be marked absent for the day. The earliest a student can be picked up for day, if he or she arrived on time, is 11:30 am. You can take your student out for an appointment and return them later in the day and as long as the minutes add up to 210 , the student is considered present for the day.

PSE uses the Remind messaging tool to get the information out in the afternoon about late buses. Remind allows parents to receive a cell phone text message with real-time late bus information. We use this system when a PSE bus is scheduled to be significantly late (more than 15 minutes). Please be aware that all bus schedules are generated by CMS Transportation and are estimates based on most current information received.
